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# Best bets for outdoor dining on Long Island: Where to eat during Phase 2

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**Gatsby's Landing** (1362 Old Northern Blvd., Roslyn): The waterside patio at Gatsby's Landing has always been one of Nassau County's most idyllic outdoor dining spots. Gaze upon Roslyn's picture-perfect pond where, at twilight, you can share cocktail hour with egrets, herons and ducks who are also out for their evening meal. Gaze down at the table and you'll be rewarded with expertly mixed cocktails, a brief but imaginative wine list and imaginative, Mediterranean-inflected fare (the summer menu just launched). Crudos and homemade pastas are particular highlights. Because the patio only accommodates 20 socially distanced seats, the restaurant has expanded its usual hours to noon to 8 p.m. every day.
